To achieve this Kingsbridge Kingfishers Swimming Club will ensure that:

- our teachers, coaches, officials and administrators will adapt provision to fit the needs of all swimmers;
- wherever and whenever possible, the Club is available to all irrespective of any disability provided the minimum entry requirements of the Club can be attained;
- on notification of any disability, the Club will make provision so that all swimmers are provided with equal support and guidance subject to the physical restraints of our home base and any other venues the Club may visit;
- we regularly review our selection and training procedures so as to be fair to all;
- if required, teachers and coaches undergo relevant training for a swimmer's special needs;
- it establishes and maintains liaison with at least one disability swimming club to ensure that disabled swimmers can reach their full potential;
- attention is also given to those with a hidden disability eg: dyslexia may mean a swimmer cannot read or understand the swimming programme.
